Bright Little Stars is a purpose built, newly renovated, gated property with private access.




Our multi-coloured fence provides a positive first impression for children and families when entering the nursery. It enables children under 2 years old (who are not reading), children with additional needs and EAL to recognise when they are arriving at nursery and to be greeted by a welcoming environment.

Barnet council wanted to remove our coloured fence on the grounds that the view of it is visually obtrusive. We legally appealed and petitioned against this and with the support of our parents, staff and local residents WON!

LEARNING ROOMS




To ensure babies are able to get the rest they need, we have designed a separate sleep section for their comfort. The Milky Way Room also features its own milk kitchen and a multisensory room to encourage children to use their senses and explore.



Bright Little Stars has 4 specially designed bright learning rooms which were designed with the children's best interest at heart. Each room is tailored to each particular age group: 6-15 months, 16-24 months, 2-3 year olds and 3-5 year olds. Each room features dual air conditioning/heating systems and has direct and sheltered access to outdoor space to allow for free flow learning both indoors and outdoors during all weathers.

PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT THROUGH SOCIAL MEDIA




The BLS Website and secure 'Parent Area' allows parents to keep in touch with events, newsletters, menus and celebrations.

Parental access Nurserycam is a tool to provide reassurance for all parents to see their children enjoying their day at nursery and be more involved in their learning.


