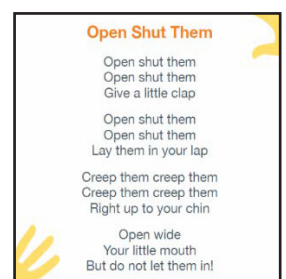
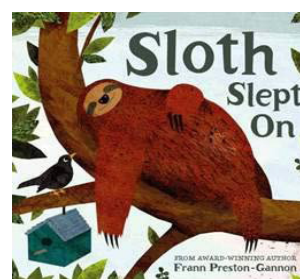
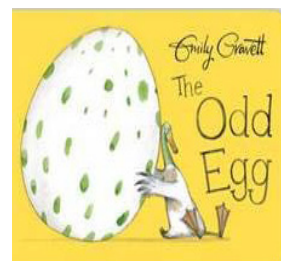
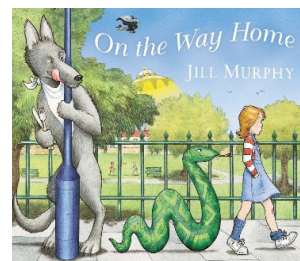
Things to do and talk about

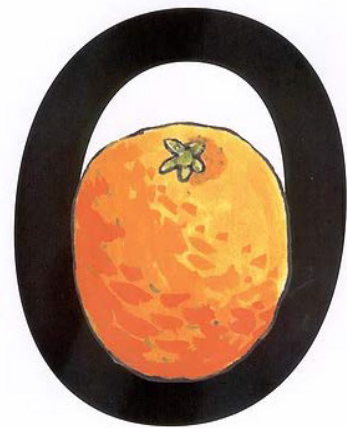
